Men's Fellowship

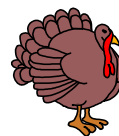
The Men's Fellowship will meet on Wednesday, November 17 at 7:00 p.m. at the Golden Corral. All men are invited to come and join them in fellowship.

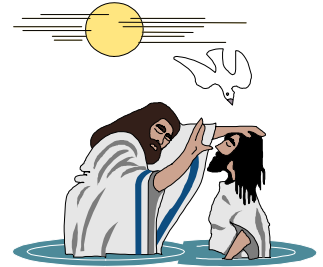
